Traffic Congestion & Parking of Cars

Firstly, I would like to thank all parents and carers for their support and who take great consideration in parking their cars away from School.

Unfortunately, we do have a number of parents who when they are in a rush in a morning park their cars, both on the yellow lines and zig zags. This is despite the messages and cones outside school and this causes more traffic congestion together with parking issues.

At the PTA meeting held on Tuesday, I received a number of parental complaints about irresponsible parking on the double yellow lines, on the school pavement and on the zigzag area, in front of the school entrance. This means parents and children are unable to cross the road safely.

The safety of the children is our priority and I ask you to be considerate and respectful when parking your cars. It would be helpful, if you would consider parking further away from school and take a few minutes to walk to the school gate. This will help alleviate any congestion.

School has been notified Manchester City Council's Traffic wardens will be patrolling the area, both in the morning and at home time and will be issuing tickets for any cars parked on the yellow lines or zigzag area.

In addition, the PTA will be supporting school with parents and children kindly asking parents to park their cars safely on Friday morning from 8.15am to 8.45am to help put the message across about parking safely. It will be a busy morning on Friday as we will be using four coaches to take our children to Chester Zoo and will be using the loading bay.
